IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS FOR OUR YWCA SCHOOL HOLIDAY PROGRAM.

YWCA SHP fees are to be paid on payment night, Tuesday 20th December from 6.30pm till 8-00pm. All fees are to be paid at this time. If you are unable to make this date/time you can send a cheque or money order prior to the start of the program.

ALL FAMILIES ARE EXPECTED TO PAY PRIOR TO THE CHILDREN ATTENDING THE PROGRAM, OTHERWISE YOU WILL LOSE YOUR CHILD/REN'S BOOKINGS.

Daily fee is \$38 per day, on excursion days or where we make a special lunch extra costs are added to the fee. CCB does apply to nearly every family. When you enrol your child/ren please provide your CRN number and your children's CRN and date of birth.

Your child/ren requires the following items every day:

- * Lunch, snacks and drink. Please provide healthy lunches consisting of sandwiches or rolls, fruit and plenty of food to last all day. Also remember we have morning snack, lunch and an afternoon snack.
- * Children are to have a large drink bottle every day especially for the programs where the weather is hot.
- * **Broad brim hats and sunscreen must be worn at our program during the warm weather. We have sunscreen for touch ups during the day. We are a sun smart program and if you don't have a hat then no play outside. NO CAPS.**
- * **Nut Allergies** We have some children who have nut allergies attending the program. Please take care that children don't have any peanut/nut products in their lunch box. These foods are something they can have at home. If there is a problem please contact the coordinator. Allergies are a very serious condition. Please help us to keep all children safe.
- * **Medication** If your child/ren requires medication during the day a written permission form must be filled out and signed with details and the medication also must be in its original bottle/package with your child's name and dosage. Please come and see the coordinator for the form.
- * **Asthma** If your child has asthma please make sure they have an asthma management plan with them when attending the program.
